

Watch Council Meetings

Medford's City Council meetings are held the first and third Thursday of every month at noon and 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The public may speak directly to the Council during the *Oral Requests and Communications* portion of these meetings. Individuals have three minutes and those representing a group have five minutes to speak.
