

# CRIME STOPPERS of Southern Oregon

Last Thursday, Our Foster Kids Inc. (a local non-profit organization dedicated to serving foster children in Josephine County), reported that one of their volunteer's vehicles was broken into the night before in the 1200 block of SW L St., Grants Pass. The perpetrator(s) of the crime broke into the locked vehicle and removed eight sealed bins filled with toys and electronics that were going to a storage facility. The stolen items include: Amazon Kindle tablets, radio controlled cars and trucks, toy drones, and handheld electronic games. Our Foster Kids Inc. had planned to store these items and then distribute them to local foster children next Christmas. The organization is also well known for providing backpacks and other items to foster kids before school each year. Now Our Foster Kids Inc., Grants Pass Department of Public Safety and Crime Stoppers of Southern Oregon need your help in identifying the suspect(s).
