## *Public Participation Sought*

Medford City Council recognizes the importance of citizen participation in municipal government. The Council invites you to participate in one of their many Boards and Commissions.

To apply, visit the City of Medford's website at [www.ci.medford.or.us](http://www.ci.medford.or.us) or pick up an application at the City Manager's Office. Applications for the following positions will be accepted through October 31.

**Arts Commission.** Meets monthly. There are two positions, with terms expiring 1/31/2018. Assists with selection, acquisition, sighting, and restoration of the City's public art.

**Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee.** Meets monthly. There are four positions, with terms expiring 01/31/2017. Advises Council on plans and issues relating to non-motorized transportation.

**Budget Committee—City.** Meets primarily in the spring to review the City's budget document. There are two positions, with terms expiring 01/31/2019. Assists City Council with the biennial budget.

**Budget Committee—Urban Renewal.** Generally meets two to three times per year. There are two positions, with terms expiring 01/31/2018. Assists City Council with the biennial budget.

**Cemetery Commission.** Meets monthly. There are three positions, with two terms expiring 01/31/2018 and one expiring 1/31/2017. Makes recommendations to Council regarding the funding and operation of the Eastwood Cemetery.

**Housing & Community Development Commission.** Meets monthly. There are four positions, with terms expiring 1/31/2018. Makes recommendations to Council on issues relating to land-use policies, zoning, use of Community Development Block Grant Funds and supports housing affordability in Medford.

**Joint Transportation Subcommittee.** Meets quarterly. There are two positions, with terms expiring 1/31/2019. Advises Council on all matters affecting transportation policy in the City.

**Landmarks & Historic Preservation Commission.** Meets monthly. There are two positions, with terms expiring 1/31/2019. Reviews and investigates any building, structure or other physical object in the City which is of historic significance.

**Mayor's Youth Advisory Commission.** Meets monthly. There are seven positions, with terms expiring 6/30/2015. Advises Council on matters concerning youth and youth activities.

**Multicultural Commission.** Meets monthly. There are four positions, three with terms expiring 01/31/2018 and one with a term expiring 01/31/2017. Advises Council on matters pertaining to the Multicultural community of the City of Medford.

**Parking Commission.** Meets monthly. There is one position, with a term expiring 01/31/2018. Advises Council on matters relating to parking in the Central Business District.

**Parks & Recreation Commission.** Meets monthly. There are four positions, three with terms expiring 1/31/2018 and one youth position with a term expiring 6/30/2015. Advises Council regarding acquisition and development of public parks, greenways and spaces, and recreation facilities.

**Planning Commission.** Meets weekly. There are four positions, three with terms expiring 1/31/2019 and one expiring 1/31/2018. Makes recommendations to Council pertaining to zoning, growth, and development in the community.

**Police Advisory Committee.** Meets quarterly. There are four positions, one for each category: resident of Ward 2, resident of Ward 4, member representing the business community and member representing the minority community. Terms expire 1/31/2017. Assists the Police Department in finding solutions to community issues and is a forum for community members regarding the Police Department.


**Site Plan & Architectural Commission.** Meets twice a month. There are three positions. Openings for a licensed architect and a licensed landscaper, with terms expiring 01/31/2019 and an at large position, with a term expiring 01/31/2017. Promotes the livability of Medford, reviews new development projects and improvements to existing structures.

**Tree Committee.** Meets monthly. There are three positions, with terms expiring 1/31/2018. Advises Parks and Recreation Commission on matters relating to trees.

**Unified Appeal Board.** Meets only when called. There is one position for a licensed contractor, with a term expiring 1/31/2016. Conducts hearings to review appeals regarding building code matters.

**Water Commission.** Meets twice a month. There is one position, with a term expiring 1/31/2020. Responsible for the management and operation of the City's water system; functions independently from other City operations.
