

## SWIM LESSON LEVELS

\*ALL LESSONS INCLUDE WATER SAFETY SKILLS.

### PARENT TOT 6mo-3yrs

**Skills taught in class:** The parent(s) learn methods of working with their child in the water and developing water safety skills. Both parents may accompany their child.

**Students are tested on the first day of class. If the student is above/below their current skill level, they will be transferred to another class, provided an opening is available.**

### STARFISH A Age 2-3

**Prerequisite skills:** Child must be able to get into the pool without parent.

**Skills taught in class:** Put head underwater, bob while taking a breath above water and blowing bubbles underwater, front float, lift head, flutter kick, front glide (arms out on front, glide on belly), beginning front crawl, assisted back float, jump into shallow water and return to starting point.

### STARFISH B Age 4-5

**Prerequisite skills:** Child must be able to get into the pool without parent.

**Skills taught in class:** Independent front float with recovery, front glide with flutter kick, beginning front crawl, roll over front glide onto back and then back onto stomach, independent front float with recovery, back glide with flutter kick.

### ANGELFISH (Level 1) Age 5+

**Prerequisite skills:** Child must be comfortable enough to enter water with minimal assistance. If your child is hesitant or fearful of water, please notify the registrar.

**Skills taught in class:** A class designed for the first time student.

### BASS (LEVEL 2) Age 5+

**Prerequisite skills:** Is comfortable in water, bobs with rhythmic breathing, independent front float, independent back float, beginning front crawl, jumps into shallow water without assistance, climbs in and out of pool, puts face in water, can put head under water and hold breath.

**Skills taught in class:** Independent front float with recovery, front glide with flutter kick, beginning front crawl, rollover glide onto back and then back to stomach, independent back float with recovery, back glide with flutter kick, elementary backstroke with flutter kick, jumps into shallow water and returns to starting point.

### CATFISH (LEVEL 3) Age 5+

**Prerequisite skills:** Beginning front crawl with front to back roll; winging and kicking on back, jumps into deep water, beginning front crawl, rolls onto back, winging and kicking to starting point, and sitting to dive.

**Skills taught in class:** Front crawl with side breathing, independent back float, back crawl, elementary backstroke with flutter kick, jump off diving board and swim to pool edge, tread water, underwater swim, elementary backstroke with beginning whip kick, and kneeling and/or standing dives.

### TROUT (Level 4) Age: 8+


**Prerequisite skills:** Beginning front crawl with front to back roll, winging and kicking on back, jumps into deep water, beginning front crawl, rolls onto back, winging and kicking to starting point, and sitting dive.

**Skills taught in class:** Front crawl with side breathing, independent back float, back crawl, elementary backstroke with flutter kick, jumps off diving board and swims to pool edge, treading water, underwater swim, elementary backstroke with beginning whip kick, and kneeling and/or standing dives. Includes introduction to dolphin kick.

### PRIVATE LESSONS (P)

One student per instructor. Lessons are taught at the student's level.

Age: 3+  
Day: Mon-Thu (2-week sessions)  
Length: 30 min.

### SEMI-PRIVATE LESSONS (SP)

Lessons are for two people of equal ability. Both participants must register for the class at the same time. Online registration not available. Lessons are taught at the student's level.

## GENERAL PARK RULES

Park Hours: 6am-10:30pm

- Alcohol: Not permitted in most park areas or facilities. Allowed in certain areas with the Park Director's approval.
- Amplification: City permission is required for amplified speech or music in a park area. *Permit Fee \$18*
- Barbecues: Please do not leave a fire unattended or leave before extinguishing any fire. Dump hot briquettes in existing fire pits or barbecues only.
- Camping: Not allowed in any park unless pre-approved by City Council.
- Dogs: Must be on a 6-foot leash in the control of a capable individual who must immediately remove any feces.
- Firearms: Firearms, fireworks and explosives are prohibited from all parks.
- Horses/Exotic Animals—Not permitted in park areas or bike paths except when approved for special events.
- Vehicles: Motorized vehicles are allowed only in designated parking areas.
- Vending: Land use regulations prohibit vending of goods except as specified in Section 2-185 of the City Code.
- Use of remote controlled devices in park areas, unless otherwise designated, is prohibited such as: cars, aircraft, model rockets and drones.

Smoking is prohibited at all City of Medford Parks.

## BEAR CREEK SKATE PARK

- All participants are required to wear protective head gear while using the Skate Park. This is a state law for those 16 years of age and younger.
- No bike riding is allowed on the skate park facility.
- Facility is for Skateboard and Roller Blade activities only.
- Use facility at your own risk.
- Do not use this facility when skate surface is wet.


## TO RESERVE A PARK OR FACILITY

Park Hours are 6am-10:30pm

- Reserve by phone with a debit/credit card by calling 774-2400.
- To pay with cash, check or money order, visit the Parks & Recreation office at the Santo Community Center.
- Bring the rental confirmation to the location/event.
- Inflatables may not be staked at any park site. Renters are required to provide valid insurance, as specified by the City. Renter is responsible for providing power.

General Use Permit:

\$55 for each 3-hour time slot. "General Use" is considered under 50 attendees, no amplification and creates no neighborhood parking impact.



**Special Event Permits:** A special permit and a site plan are required for events and activities that generate high spectator, traffic, parking or park-impact volumes such as festivals, car shows, events using booths, etc. Please call MPRD well in advance to plan and coordinate the event.

**Bear Creek Amphitheater:** Most events at these facilities require a Special Event Permit. If the event only requires chairs, you reserve by phone with a debit/credit card, or come in person to the Santo Community Center to pay with cash.

## SANTO COMMUNITY CENTER RENTALS

Rooms are often available for meetings, family gatherings or presentations. Rooms accommodate up to 49 people, and the Main Hall can hold up to 150. Tables, chairs provided. TVs and projectors available in many rooms.


