



What Commissioners See on iPad – Zoom Virtual Meeting


When you've clicked the link in the email invite and log into the Zoom app, this is what you'll see




Once the meeting has started, your screen will look like this. Click Call using Internet Audio.




You're in! Your microphone will automatically be muted when you join the meeting. Be sure the mic is unmuted so you can be heard. The microphone icon is green when unmuted.




You can see who is participating in the meeting.




As a commissioner, you're a panelist. You can see others that have also logged in to attend the meeting. They are able to speak and give testimony. (Please disregard the Chat button at the bottom. That's a written chat – you'll all be speaking, just as if we were in chambers.)



If you'd like to be recognized, you can either speak or raise your hand. You can see whose hand is raised in the list of participants. Again, please don't chat.



At the end of the meeting, click Leave Meeting.
