# About Medford

**Medford, Oregon**, owes its origin in the early 1880s to the decision of the Oregon & California Railroad to run its line through the center of the Bear Creek Valley.

It was at the “middle ford” of Bear Creek that the railroad, working south from Portland, planned to cross the stream and start a new town. The name first chosen for the new town site was “Middle Ford,” but railroad engineer David Loring was from Medford, Mass., and he soon shortened the name to “Medford.”


In its first 125 years, Medford has grown from a small town with unpaved roads to the largest city in Southern Oregon and the seat of Jackson County.

Once primarily dependent on timber and agriculture, Medford is a thriving regional trade center with a growing residential population, expanding medical facilities, growing retail opportunities, expanding economic development, increasing tourism and abundant recreational opportunities.

# About *The Park*



## U.S. Cellular Community Park (USCCP)

is owned and operated by the City of Medford. The facility features 15 sports fields including five softball/baseball, five multi-sport, and three baseball. The five-field softball/baseball complex opened on May 9, 2008, and has already hosted more than 26,000 youth and adult games.

Aloha Grill operates concession stands at the softball/baseball and multi-sport complexes.

U.S. Cellular paid \$650,000 for six years of park naming-rights -- the largest naming-rights agreement for a municipal facility in Oregon history.



## How to Register

Fill out a registration form on the youth baseball tournament page at [www.sportsmedford.com](http://www.sportsmedford.com). Tournament fees are due by 5 p.m. Friday prior to the week of the event. Tournament fees are non-refundable after this date/time.

Tournaments may fill up prior to the registration deadline. Simply calling or emailing the Tournament Director does not "hold" your spot. Only full payment will reserve your team's spot in the tournament.

## Age Requirements and Bat Policy

A player's age must not exceed the specified age of the division before May 1 of the current season. Medford Parks and Recreation requires all baseball bats meet the traditional 1.15 BPF (Bat Performance Factor) and maximum 2 3/4" bat barrel size standards. All bats must be stamped with the 1.15 BPF or "BBCOR" mark to be used in games or warm-ups at USCCP. Bats are subject to inspection at any time by umpires or tournament officials while participants are on City property. USSSA-stamped bats are permitted in U14 age group games.






