Concerts are held at Pear Blossom Park Block 2 on Thursday evenings. Concerts begin at 6:30pm however, set up and other activities begin at 5pm and take down can take until 9pm.

Volunteer may be asked to perform one or more of the following:

- ◆ Set up for sponsor booth
- ◆ Distribute Parks and Recreation activity material; flyers, coupons, etc.
- ◆ Distribute and collect customer surveys
- ◆ Take down of tents, chairs, etc.
- ◆ Internship Available

Desirable Qualifications:

- ◆ Follow written and verbal instruction
- ◆ Perform physical labor safely
- ◆ Work with minimal supervision
- ◆ Relate to general public in a positive manner

Equipment:

- ◆ Volunteer to provide and carry a charged cell phone at events

Special Requirements:

Volunteer needs to complete the Volunteer Application and pass a City of Medford background check; does not apply to organized clubs or groups planning a one time drop in work day.

Volunteers must follow all safety guidelines as demonstrated by City and outlined in Illness and Injury Prevention Plan and be willing to submit to training if necessary. If volunteer cannot perform any duty at the site/event they need to notify staff prior to or at event. This will not disqualify them from volunteering, only from getting an injury.
