City Council had a study session last month regarding the Water Wise Site Development Committee. Council requested that the committee resume work on the standards along with a few new items for the committee to look at such as opportunities for demonstration gardens and potential incentive programs to encourage property owners to conserve water (related to landscaping).

Prior to forwarding information about resuming the committee, we are polling the current members to find out if they are still able to serve on the committee.
