## **NOTICE TO INTERESTED PARTIES**

### **SUBJECT: FLOOD INSURANCE RATE MAP ZONE INFORMATION**

As a free, public service, the City of Medford will provide you with the following information upon request:

- Review of a property to identify whether it is in or out of the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) as shown on the Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) of the City.
- Additional flood insurance data for a site such as the FIRM zone and the Base Flood Elevation (B.F.E.) if shown on the FIRM.
- A handout on the flood insurance purchase requirements that can help people who need a mortgage or loan for a property in the SFHA.
- If available, a copy of a FEMA Flood Elevation Certificate for buildings constructed in the floodplain since 1992.

Please contact us regarding your inquiry and identify the street address or map and tax lot number for the property. Our office is open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday to assist you at the counter or by telephone.
