- Identification and prioritization of MURA projects in the Liberty Park area north of Jackson Street
- Continued revitalization of Downtown utilizing MURA land assets and funds for seismic retrofit
- Investigation of potential areas of the City that may benefit from urban renewal activities

- One member with experience in real estate and construction (including market-rate housing)
- One member with experience in affordable housing
- One member with experience in transportation (including transit and multi-modal)
- One member with experience in social services (including homelessness)
- One member with experience in economic development and/or workforce development
- Two members-at-large encouraging representation from throughout the whole community
