PARK USE REGULATION

- HOURS** - 6:00 P.M. - 10:30 P.M. unless posted otherwise.
- CAMPING/
OVERNIGHT
SLEEPING** - Camping/overnight sleeping is prohibited in any park areas. Ordinance 5.257.
- ALCOHOL &
NARCOTICS** - Alcoholic beverages and narcotics are not allowed in any park area.
- VEHICLES** - Motorized vehicles are allowed in designated parking areas only and are prohibited on all paths.
- ANIMALS** - Dogs must be on a leash, and under the control of the capable individual who must immediately remove any feces if the dog defecates on public property. Ordinance 5.600.
- TOBACCO
& SMOKE** - All Parks and Recreation Department managed properties are designated as tobacco and smoke free. Ordinance 5.265.
- DUMPING** - Discarding or depositing any junk, garbage, scrap, charcoal, or debris is prohibited. Ordinance 5.285(a).
