



Below is a summary of the Achievements and Accomplishments for the Public Works Department during 2009-2010.

Public Works:

Completed Projects:

1. Table Rock/Merriman Intersection improvements (17-transportation projects).
2. Sodium Bisulfite storage tank at the Regional Water Reclamation Facility (RWRf).
3. Completed Safe Sidewalks for Schools phases 5A and 5B. Also completed 22% of all needed sidewalks.
4. Vector Waste Receiving facility at Service Center (environmental compliance).
5. Traffic signal at Golf View and Barnett.
6. Bike lanes on 4th and 10th Streets.

Accomplishments:

1. Sidewalk repair permits now available on-line.
2. Assisted with traffic control and logistics (fuel) on Deer Ridge fire.
3. Provided activated sludge to Crescent City for start up of their new sewage treatment plant.
4. Entered into new agreement with 549c School District to maintain their vehicles.
5. Created brochures with information about SDCs, sidewalk maintenance responsibilities, and storm drainage.
6. Operations and Water Reclamation Divisions each earned the Frank Bertak Safety Committee award from the American Society of Safety Engineers.
7. RWRf upper drying bed paving project earned a 1st place award from the Asphalt Paving Association of Oregon.
