YOUTH RECREATION PROGRAMS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

3. Scholarship amounts will vary from program to program. A list of scholarship discounts will be established each season and made available to applicants.
4. By accepting a partial scholarship, the parent/guardian agrees to be responsible for the payment of any fees above the scholarship amount.
5. Out-of-city fees must be paid; they are not covered by your scholarship.
6. Parents/guardians may be asked to help volunteer for a program to help offset the cost of the scholarship.
