#### JUNE 19 .....AMERICAN GRAFFITI (PG)

**Richard Dreyfuss, Ronny Howard**—This film from director George Lucas was selected by the American Film Institute as one of the greatest 100 movies ever made. Four California teenagers who are unsure of their futures spend summer nights cruisin' and hangin' out in this look at the last "innocent" year of the '50s and early '60s. [1974]

#### JUNE 20 .....GREASE (PG)

**John Travolta, Olivia Newton-John**—John Travolta solidified his position as the most versatile and magnetic screen presence of the decade in GREASE, one of the most successful motion pictures of all time. Recording star Olivia Newton-John made her American film debut as Sandy, Travolta's painfully naive love interest. GREASE was not just a nostalgic look at a simpler decade, peopled with characters of universal appeal, this re-release is an energetic and exciting homage to the age of rock 'n roll! [1978]

#### JUNE 27 .....IRON MAN (PG-13)

**Robert Downey Jr, Gwyneth Paltrow, Terrence Howard**—After an accident, billionaire industrialist Tony Stark creates a suit that sustains his life. When he heals, he uses his technology to fight crime and leads a double life as Iron Man in this comic book adventure. [2008]

#### JULY 11 .....FIREPROOF (PG)

**Kirk Cameron, Erin Bethea, Ken Bevel**—Lt. Caleb Holt lives by the old firefighter's adage: Never leave your partner behind. At work this comes to him naturally but he has trouble applying the principle to his cooling marriage. As a final effort he decides to embark on a 40-day experiment called "The Love Dare" that necessitates being kind to his wife in an effort to rediscover what brought them together in the first place. 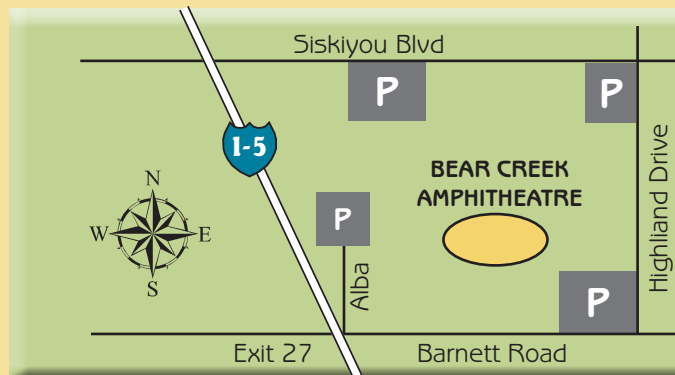
**Pre-Show Event: Grass volleyball for all ages.**
