This letter is on behalf of MD-9 Oak Grove of which I have an ownership interest in approximately 16 acres (535 Oak Grove) of the 103 Acres being recommended for inclusion in the current urban growth boundary amendment. The Oak Grove portion of MD-9 was included in the original recommendation from the Planning Commission and again in the Proposed Urban Growth Boundary Amendment, thank you.

We have had numerous neighborhood meetings and strong attendance/support from other properties owners throughout this process and from that I can tell you we as a group are very thankful for your continued support to include our neighborhood into the urban growth boundary. Not only will the inclusion provide much needed affordable new housing but will provide an opportunity for the small developer/contractor to play a role in the growth of our community.

A lot of people have talked about affordable housing in their developments throughout these meetings, but historically the most affordable new housing has been developed in West Medford of which there is a very small percentage of property included in this amendment. It is our belief that this area will better support the Blue Collar worker, the single parent family and those new family's that struggle to buy their first home.
