No Permit Required – 1 & 2 Family Dwellings, with Conditions

- Conditions:**
- Appliances used per manufacturer's safety requirements
 - Only dry wood or charcoal briquettes can be burned
 - Recommended used only on non-combustible surface or pad
 - In other than one and two family dwellings, required minimum 15' from structure or combustible material
 - Must use a safety screen

- Conditions when fires are prohibited:**
- During extreme fire danger level
 - Expected winds > 20 mph
 - Expected temperatures > 90°F
 - A woodburning advisory red or yellow day (call: 541-776-9000)

Bonfire

Not Allowed

[Yard Debris Burning](#)

Allowed by Permit only - with Conditions

- Conditions:**
- Only cut yard trimmings, leaves and brush are allowed to be burned
 - Maximum pile size 4' or less in diameter and 3' or less in height or in a burn barrel
 - Minimum 50' from structure (min. 25' for piles sizes <= 3' diameter x 2' height)
 - Constant supervision and method of extinguishment

- Conditions when fires are prohibited:**
- November 1 thru February 29
 - During declared fire season
 - After dark
 - Expected winds > 20 mph
 - Temperatures > 90°F
 - A no-burn day (call: 541-776-7007)

Barbeque

No Permit Required

[Fire Pit](#) using Solid Fuels (in-ground)

Allowed by Permit only - with Conditions

- Conditions:**
- Only dry wood or charcoal briquettes can be burned
 - Maximum pile size 3' or less in diameter and 2' or less in height
 - Minimum 25' from structure or combustible material
 - Must use a safety screen for fire pits

- Conditions when fires are prohibited:**
- During extreme fire danger level
 - Expected winds > 20 mph
 - Temperatures > 90°F
 - A woodburning advisory red or yellow day (call: 541-776-9000)

[Recreational](#) (Ceremonial, Religious, Pleasure, Cooking)

Allowed by Permit Only - with Conditions

[Agricultural & Special](#)

Allowed by Permit Only - with Conditions

- Conditions:**
- Manageable pile sizes
 - Ability to provide extinguishment should conditions change
 - Minimum 50' from any structure
 - Fuel breaks around fire area
 - Constant supervision and method of extinguishment
 - Ag. blight burning allowed year-round, with conditions. A Special Burn Permit required during fire season and Nov. 1 – Feb. 29

- Conditions when fires are prohibited:**
- Agricultural - During declared fire season and Nov. 1 – Feb. 29
 - After dark
 - Expected winds > 20 mph
 - Temperatures > 90°F
 - A no-burn day (541-776-7007)
