TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HAWTHORNE PARK

Hawthorne Park was closed to all individuals for 48 hours on Tuesday, September 22 through Thursday, September 24 to allow for sanitation, cleaning and inspection of City property.

This closure was in response to the health and sanitary conditions of the park following the creation of an unauthorized urban campground.

Prior to enforcing the park closure, the Medford Livability Team reached out to local shelter operators in an effort to expand capacity for individuals and held a resource fair to connect individuals in the park with services and information regarding available shelters throughout the Rogue Valley.

Participating agencies included Jackson County Mental Health, Rogue Retreat (Kelly Shelter, Hope Village, Urban Campground), Men's and Women's Gospel Mission, and La Clinica.

Transportation was offered and utilized by individuals at the park throughout the day to local shelter locations and La Clinica. As a result, Rogue Retreat reserved spaces in the Kelly Shelter and Urban campground specifically for individuals in Hawthorne Park.

Ultimately, 31 individuals were placed at the mentioned shelters.

Residents participating in the leaf collection program must provide their own heavy-duty bags. Bags may not be larger than 33 gallons.


