Drug Take Back & Rogue Shred Event

Medford Police Department hosts this event twice per year to provide our community with a safe, convenient, and responsible means to dispose of unwanted, unused or outdated prescription medications for **free**. The event also serves as an educational tool to assist the general public in understanding the potential for abuse of these medications.

Medford Police Department is also partnering with Rogue Disposal & Recycling Inc. to conduct a **free** shred event. This service allows citizens an opportunity to securely shred sensitive and confidential documents. Participating in Rogue Shred Day can reduce the potential of becoming a victim of identity theft.

NOTE: Material is intended for household material and is limited to four paper grocery sacks per vehicle.

SCHOOL ZONE SAFETY

School is back in session and school zones are active. Here are five things to remember:



- The speed limit is 20 mph in school zones in any of the following situations: any time a yellow light on a school speed sign is flashing, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. on school days, and around crosswalks near school grounds when children are present.
- Never pass a car that is stopped for pedestrians.
- Oregon law requires drivers to stop for all school buses with flashing red lights. You're required by law to remain stopped until the lights are off and children are out of the way.
- Always obey school zone speed limit signs. Remember, traffic fines usually double in school zones.
- Be alert for children who might dart across the street or between vehicles on their way to school.

Please be alert, keep your eyes open for children, school zone signs and school bus lights. Drive safely!
